The FREE Ecoliving Fair shuttle bus...

The bus leaves Randwick City Council's Bowen Library, 669-673 Anzac Parade, Maroubra, at the following times or thereabouts then makes 4 scheduled stops to pick up and set down passengers...

Stop 1: Bowen Library

Stop 2: Bus stops outside South Juniors (cnr Waller Street & Anzac Parade southbound)

Stop 3: Botany Road bus stop (cnr High Street)

Stop 4: Adjacent to Park - Alison Road bus stop
